In response to national and EU lobbying efforts by the Global Campaign, researchers, product developers and their respective partner organisations, EU funding for microbicide research and development has increased dramatically since 2002. Despite these welcome increases, European spending on microbicides still accounts for a fraction of its HIV-related research spending. As more microbicide candidates are advanced into later-stage clinical trials and as the development costs rise correspondingly, the current levels of funding will remain inadequate.
