The contribution the nominee has made in or shown in:

- Specific projects or activities to apply community-based advocacy to HIV prevention research.
- Building, nurturing and sustaining relationships between communities, advocacy and research, especially in resource-poor settings.
- Inspired other advocates/groups to get involved - Demonstrated communication, mentoring and leadership skills.
- Demonstrated commitment to the issues and approaches embraced by Omololu Falobi.
- Predominant activities in developing countries and with marginalized communities.
- Evidence of serious and long-term commitment to HIV prevention research advocacy.

The Review Committee will also consider:

- Potential for award strengthening nominee's ongoing work.
- Potential for receipt of this award raising the profile of the Omololu Falobi Award itself.
- Potential that the nominee will enhance visibility, public awareness and impact of community advocacy within HIV prevention research.

Nominations of people living/working in the developing world, and/or living with HIV, and and/or working in the media – are strongly encouraged.
